School uniforms are required for kids to stay in school. However, parents struggle to afford the uniforms which include blazers, sweaters, dresses and rain jackets. Breakfast and lunch are served daily and are often the only meals the kids will have that day.

emergency funds

With a high rate of crime, emergency funds are necessary to cover funeral expenses hospital visits, trauma counselors, relocation help and legal representation.

In addition, basic necessities are needed like access to the Internet, clothes for job interviews and transportation.

Goal: \$1000 monthly



safe transportation for girls



The cost and danger of public transportation limits the options for women and girls. A safe, reliable driver and vehicle guarantees their safety. An on-call driver will be available for pregnant mothers.

Cost: \$47k, includes a car and dedicated driver

Two staff leaders live in gang-controlled areas. Giving them a place to thrive and care for others will expand their capacity to serve others and change their family legacy.

Cost: \$52k (one 3 bed house)
